Medical Mission to Haiti March 2012

The Parish of the Epiphany is sending a medical mission team to Leogane, Haiti from March 17 to 26, 2012. Leogane lies in the epicenter of the earthquake in 2010. We will stay in the Hopital Ste Croix and work in villages near Leogane. We will see 150 patients per day in mobile medical clinics.
